This has a polyethylene core sandwiched on either side by 0.33mm thick polyester coated aluminium. Probond has an extremely flat surface on both sides, which makes it ideal for both digital and screen-printing. Probond can be used for flat applications, routing and folding.

Due to high demand in recent months, and customer feedback regarding its high quality and ease of use, we have now started to add a colour range. Colours currently on offer are, Sea Blue, Red, Black, Mirror, Metallic Silver, Soft Gold, Silver and Gold Brushed Finish. We are also in the process of adding more colours including Dark Blue, Yellow and British Racing Green.

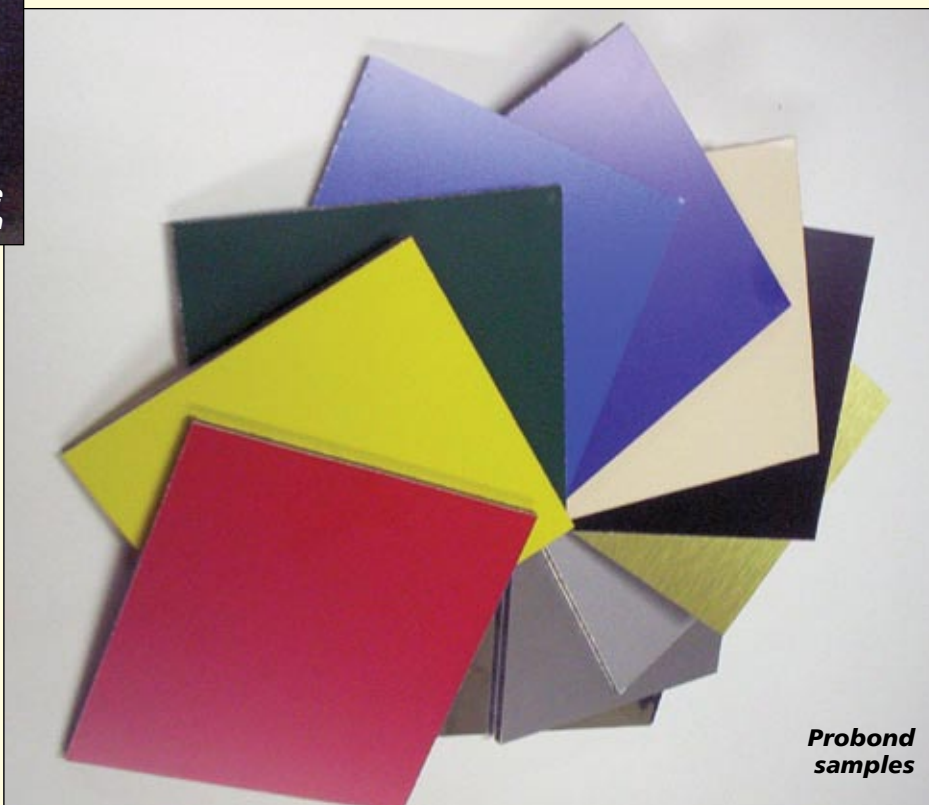
Foamalite is our Foam PVC brand.

This is a high quality foamboard with an excellent fine surface especially suitable for vinyl applications. Colours available include White, Black, Blue, Red, Yellow, Cream, Green and Grey. Swatches are valuable on request. Other materials we supply include cast and extruded acrylic, polycarbonate, PET, PETG, Gloss Foam PVC, Correx and Gear Trays.

Owing to the sheer demand from customers requiring cut panels we are looking at investing in a beam saw. Not only will this increase our cutting facilities and help reduce cutting times, but it will also allow us to cut to a tighter tolerance with a cleaner edge.

At the moment we only deliver in our own vans to West Yorkshire, Lancashire and Liverpool. However, with the response we have been getting from the Sign Site, we have been delivering as far afield as London and Cornwall by using a carrier service. Even with the carriage costs this service is still working out cheaper for our customers."
